Precast concrete plays a major role in providing the built environment from domestic to industrial buildings, transport and other critical infrastructures. Precasting itself has changed significantly in the materials used and methods of manufacture in the last two decades.

At the root of precasting is consistency, control and quality that impact on changing construction site procedures and habits e.g. offsite construction.
