- 2. NIVANT ANDH MUKTA VIKASALAYA (NAMV) With the support of Lodge Burnett:
 - 1) 40 disabled students are appearing for the Maharashtra State Board Examination
 - 2) 21 are appearing for the Bachelor's Degree and 4 for the M.A. Examination of the University of Pune
 - 3) 20 have got gainful employment with various private organizations
 - 4) 6 graduates have passed the Selection Written Test for Public Sector Banks and have appeared for the final Interview in February 2014; Results are expected
 - 5) Last year, 8 students cleared the written test and interviews and are now happily employed in major Public Sector Banks like SBI, PNB, BOB and BOM
 - 6) The WM, W. Bro. K.G.S. Nagpal, has been regularly, over the past two years, training and preparing these students for their interview; and the results have been excellent
