- 4. Work at a lodge CTCHIP event.
- 5. Serve on an investigation committee.
- 6. Assist at least once with the preparation of candidates.
- 7. Assist at least once with setting up of the lodge room.
- 8. Attend one meeting of the Building/Temple Association.
- 9. Attend 1 Communication of Grand Lodge.
- 10. Attend two Blue Lodge Council meetings. (can be your district or another district)
- 11. Attend a St. Johns' Day service.
- 12. Visit an elderly brother, tour any Masonicare facility or visit with a Masonic Widow
- 13. Attend a Masonic funeral service.
- 14. March in a parade with a lodge.
- 15. Give a lecture during a degree.
- 16. Serve as a pro tem officer in a lodge meeting.
- 17. Attend one Grand Lodge seminar.
- 18. Attend a Table Lodge or Ladies at Table.
